9:00 a.m.	The Instructor will begin the class, share important logistics and norms with the students, introduce the Participating Teacher, and introduce the content topic. The Participating Teacher(s) will act as the class moderator and assist the Instructor as needed, including monitoring the Chat traffic.
9:30 a.m.	Five-minute stretch break (Participants should not log out but mute their microphone and turn off their video camera if on.
9:35 a.m.	Resume instruction.

10:05 a.m.	10- minute break and transition to small group question and answer period. Participating teacher(s) will organize students into small groups.
